ORDER



Brief Facts of the Case

During the spot hearing at ESO-Khuntlipali, of Bheden Electrical Sub-division under Bargarh Electrical Division on dt. 10-02-2025, the complainant appeared before the Forum whereas SDO- Bheden appeared as respondent before the Forum.

Brief facts pertaining to the case are that the Complainant is a LT-IRRIGATION PUMPING AND AGRICULTURE consumer having consumer No. 5120-0116-0410 with connected load of 22.38 KW. That the Complainant has raised objection regarding charging of abnormal meter rent in energy bill and charging of erroneous energy bill in the month of Mar 2023. He requested before the Forum to direct the Opposite Party to resolve the billing Dispute.

Gist of Arguments made by the Parties

Both parties were present in the hearing. The contentions made by the parties are as follows:

1. Submission of the Complainant:

- 1. The complainant submits that, one new LTCT meter was installed in his premises replacing the old W.C Meter and meter rent of Rs. 500/- is being charged in the energy bill.
- 2. He further submits that; abnormal energy bill was charged in the month of Mar 2023.
- 3. He also requested the Forum to revise the bills.

2. Reply Submission of the Respondent:

- i. The Opposite Party submitted the Physical Verification Report dt. 14.02.2025, Meter Change Protocol dt. 02.03.2023 and written submission to the case.
- ii. The Opposite Party submitted that, the energy bills have been raised on actual meter reading basis recorded by the installed meter. One new LTCT meter bearing SI no. TWSL11001572 was installed in the complainant's premises on dt. 02.03.2023 by replacing the old LTCT meter bearing SI no. WES53461. Due to mis-punching of meter type, the meter rent has been levied @ Rs. 1000/- per month up to Jul 2023 which was later on rectified in the month of Aug 2023.But again in the process of updating the meter



type to comply the tariff order 24-25, for allowing rebate on TOD TPWODL consumption, the wrong entry again resulted in erroneous levy of meteral rent @ Rs. 150/- per month, which has been rectified in Dec 2024 ofter detection.

- iii. The Opposite Party submitted that, no Whole Current meter was ever installed in the complainant's premises meant for the said LI Point. For both the old and new LTCT meters, the chargeable meter rent is Rs. 500/per month.
- iv. The Opposite Party further submitted that, as per internal guideline of the management of TPWODL, LTCT meters are being installed in case of consumers having load more than 20 KW.In case of load having CD >20 KW, it is always advisable to install LTCT meter because load above 20KW having motive force may take Ampere beyond the rated value of the installed equipment when the Power factor is low. In order to accommodate the increased Ampere flow, it is always preferable to install an appropriate rated LTCT meter to take more Amperes.
- v. Further the energy bill for the month of Mar 2023 was raised on actual meter reading basis taking into account the FMR of the old meter. Hence there is no dispute in billing.

Findings and observations of the Forum

Written/verbal Submissions were made by both parties and arguments were heard at length. This Forum, after hearing the parties and going through the relevant documents, FG and Samadhan database (Licensee's soft records) and provisions of law have concluded as follows:

- That the Forum construed that, the meter rents have been charged to the complainant as per the guideline. Hence, there is no scope for revision of the meter rent.
- Further, the complainant's averment regarding the abnormal energy bill charged in the month of Mar 2023, the Opposite Party clarified that, the energy bill for the month of Mar 2023 was raised on actual meter reading basis taking into account the FMR of the old meter. Hence, then Forum is of the view that, there is no abnormality in billing.

Therefore, the instant case is hereby dropped.
