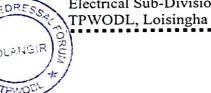

### ORDER (Dt.09.01.2025)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Sukadeb Majhi who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.5 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from the date of supply to Jan.-2024. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

### **PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 07.01.2025**

## SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Agalpur section of Loisingha Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills due to no meter in his premises from the date of power supply to Jan.-2024. For that average bill, the arrear amount has been accumulated to ₹7,738.61p upto Dec.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

## SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant records. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Oct.-2018. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from the date of power supply to Jan-2024 was due to no meter in his premises. A new meter with sl. no. TWB306034 has been installed on 18th Jan. 2024, thereafter actual billing is going on. As the above-stated average billing period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed

bills and pass order as deemed fit.

#### FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 01<sup>st</sup> Oct. 2018 and total outstanding upto Dec.-2024 is ₹ 7,738.61p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. The consumer has availed power supply without meter from the date of power supply i.e. 01<sup>st</sup> Oct. 2018 to Jan-2024 which violates Cl-97 (ii) of OERC Dist. Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is a gross negligence on the part of OP which should not be. The Forum has taken this as a <u>serious note</u> and warned the OP not to repeat such things in future.
- 2. The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter with sl. no. TWB306034 has been installed on 18<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2024, thereafter actual billing is going on. Due to billing with unmetered status, the consumer was served with average bills from the date of power supply to Jan-2024 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.
- 3. During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 4,051.59p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.
- 4. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 7,738.61p upto Dec.-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of  $\stackrel{?}{\stackrel{\checkmark}{}}$  4,051.59p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
