ORDER (Dt.25.03.2025)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Hajaru Meswa who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.5 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from the date of power supply to Jun-2022. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 19.03.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under REC section of Balangir-II Sub-division. The consumer represented that he has been served with average bills due to defective meter in his premises from the date of power supply to Jun-2022. For that average bill, the arrear amount has been accumulated to ₹ 16,144.70p upto Feb.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Jul-2013. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from the date of power supply to Jun-2022 was due to defective meter in his premises. A new meter with sl. no. TPWODL1050145 has been installed on 07th Aug. 2022, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated average billing period bill has not yet revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 12th Jul. 2013 and total outstanding upto Feb.-2025 is ₹ 16,144.70p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. The consumer has availed power supply with defective meter from the initial date of power supply to Jun-2022 which violates Cl-97 (ii) of OERC Dist. Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is a gross negligence on the part of OP which should not be. The Forum has taken this as a <u>serious note</u> and warned the OP not to repeat such things in future.
- 2. The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter with sl. no. TPWODL1050145 has been installed on 07th Aug. 2022, thereafter actual billing has been done. Due to billing with defective meter status, the consumer was served with average bills from the date of power supply to Jun-2022 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.
- 3. During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the post-meter installation consumption pattern and an amount of ₹ 12,160.22p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.
- 4. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 16,144.70p upto Feb.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 12,160.22p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
