ORDER

(Dt.27.01.2026)

During Camp Court hearing at Kandajuri PSS on 16th Jan. 2026, the consumer Shri Radha Kanta Chirgun has present & Shri Sunil Kumar Swain, SDO-II, Balangir was also present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition has been filed by the consumer Shri Radha Kanta Chirgun who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.5 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Jul-2024 to Feb-2025. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED : 16.01.2026

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Chatamakhna Section of Balangir-II Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Jul-2024 to Feb-2025 due to meter defective. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 37,419.46p upto Dec.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Aug.-2018. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Jul.-2024 to Feb.-2025 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TWB163195 has been installed on 22nd Mar. 2025, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not yet been revised, it needs bill revision as per CI-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.



FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 14th Aug. 2018 and total outstanding upto Dec.-2025 is ₹ 37,419.46p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he has been served with average bills from Jul.-2024 to Feb.-2025 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with a meter no. TWB163195 on 22nd Mar. 2025, thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter as per Cl-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with a defective meter for six months which violates Cl-155 of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code-2019 and also attracts under Schedule-III of Guaranteed Standard of Performance of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code. Hence, it is advised the OP to be more pro-active for replacement of defective meter within standard time as prescribed by Hon'ble OERC. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 6,900.52p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was also convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 6,900.52p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal which must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
