HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Bhabani Shankar Thanapati who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Dec14/Jan15 to Mar-2019. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED : 07.04.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Mahadevpali section of Binka Sub-division. The complainant represented that he has been served with average bills from Dec14/Jan15 to Mar-2019. For that disputed bill, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 11,373.68p upto Mar.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Feb-2003. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Dec14/Jan15 to Mar-2019 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. LW285095 has been installed on 31st Mar. 2019 against that defective meter, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 2 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 17th Feb. 2003 and total outstanding upto Mar.-2025 is ₹ 11,373.68p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Dec14/Jan15 to Mar-2019 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. LW285095 on 31st Mar. 2019 and thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than four years. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 10,071.01p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 11,373.68p upto Mar.-2025.

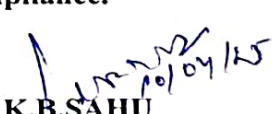
In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 10,071.01p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
