HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Rajib Thanapati who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.14 KW. He has disputed about the erroneous bills raised from the date of supply to Dec-2023. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 07.04.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Mahadevpali section of Binka Sub-division. The consumer represented that he has been served with erroneous bills from the date of power supply to Dec-2023. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 10,975.22p upto Mar.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Nov.-2012. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the erroneous billing from the date of power supply to Dec.-2023 is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to eratic meter reading punched by concerned meter reader during that period. The same energy meter (meter sl. no.: 985962) of the consumer is still continuing from the date of power supply. So, the above-stated period is to be recasted as per actual meter reading of the new meter to redress the consumer grievances. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.14 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 16th Nov. 2012 and total outstanding upto Mar.-2025 is ₹ 10,975.22p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. The consumer represented that erroneous billing has been done from the date of power supply to Dec-2023 which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.



The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to erroneous meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed erroneously. The same meter is still existing in the consumer premises. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 1,486.88p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 10,975.22p upto Mar.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 1,486.88p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
