ORDER (Dt.15.04.2025)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Smt. Sukanti Chhatria who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 3 KW. She has disputed about the provisional & average bill raised from Jul-2018 to Dec-2023. She has filed her grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 11.04.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Loisingha section of Loisingha Sub-division. The complainant represented that she has been served with provisional & average bills from Jul-2018 to Dec-2023. For that disputed bill, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 72,881.52p upto Mar.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply prior to Apr-1999. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the provisional & average billing from Jul-2018 to Dec-2023 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. 300087811 has been installed on 01st Feb. 2024 against that defective meter, thereafter actual billing has been done. A bill revision has been done by the back-end team for the preceding two year and withdrawn ₹ 16,236.74 in the bill of Sep-2024. Now, bill revision required in obedience to TPWODL guidelines.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed

bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 3 KW. The consumer has availed power supply prior to Apr-1999 and total outstanding upto Feb.-2025 is ₹ 72,881.52p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Jul-2018 to Dec-2023 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. 300087811 on 01st Feb. 2024 and thereafter actual billing has been done. A bill revision has been done by the back-end team for the preceding two year and withdrawn ₹ 16,236.74p in Sep-2024. The average billing period from Jul-2018 to Dec-2023 needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter in obedience to TPWODL guidelines with reversal of previous bill revision.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than five years. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹70,378.39p (₹86,615.13p - ₹16,236.74p) is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 72,881.52p upto Feb.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of $\stackrel{?}{\stackrel{?}{?}}$ 70,378.39p ($\stackrel{?}{\stackrel{?}{?}}$ 86,615.13p $-\stackrel{?}{\stackrel{?}{?}}$ 16,236.74p). Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
