OPPOSITE PARTY

ORDER (Dt.30.04.2025)

During spot hearing at Khaprakhol consumer camp on dt.21.04.2025 the Complainant Sri Pabitra Kumbhar appeared before the Forum in person whereas Sri Smarak Panigrahi, Accountant, Electrical Sub-Division, TPWODL, Patnagarh appeared as representative of opposite party.

The Complainant bearing consumer no. 912314063271 in his written petition dt.21.04.2025 disputed the bill raised for Rs.776.33ps during the month of March'2025 despite his regular payment of monthly bills. He therefore requested before the Forum to look into the facts and waive out the same by way of a suitable bill revision.

The opposite party on the other hand submitted a billing statement concerning to the period from April'2018 to March'2025. He also requested before the Forum to do the needful as deemed fit in this regard.

The Forum after going through all the relevant records placed before it observed that;

1. Monthly bills on provisional basis have been done from August'2022 to January'2024.

2. A new meter has been installed bearing no. TWB139048 on 2nd March'2024, thereafter actual billing have been done.

Thus, an upward assessment appears to have been done for Rs.776.23ps on replacement of a meter on dt.02.03.2024. The Forum finds no base for raising of such an upward bill and the opposite party was also agreed to it which might be owing to any software error. Finally, the Complainant was also convinced with the statement of the opposite party for proposed withdrawal of Rs.776.23ps arising out of an upward assessment due to software error.

The Forum therefore directed the opposite party to carry-out the revision proposal on proposed withdrawal of Rs.776.23ps which needs to be reflected in the next bill.
