#### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Subal Nial who is a LT-GPS consumer availing a CD of 4 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Jul-2023 to Feb-2024. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

#### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 21.04.2025

## SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Khaprakhol section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The complainant represented that he has been served with average bills from Jul-2023 to Feb-2024. For that disputed bill, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 24,775.17p upto Mar.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

### SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-GPS consumer availing power supply since Feb-2007. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Jul-2023 to Feb-2024 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TWB153063 has been installed on 17<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2024 against that defective meter, thereafter actual billing has been done. A bill revision has been done for delay meter updation for the period Jan.-2024 to Feb.-2024 and withdrawn ₹ 5,316.03p in the bill of Mar-2024. Now, bill revision required from Jul-2023 to Dec-2023 as the above-stated period bill has not yet been revised.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

#### FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-GPS. consumer with a CD of 4 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 21<sup>st</sup> Feb. 2007 and total outstanding upto Mar.-2025 is ₹ 24,775.17p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Jul-2023 to Feb-2024 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. TWB153063 on 17<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2024 and thereafter actual billing has been done. Also, a bill revision has been done for the period Jan-2024 to Feb-2024 for delay meter updation and withdrawn ₹ 5,316.03p in Mar.-2024. The average billing period from Jul-2023 to Dec-2023 needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the GPS consumer to continue with defective meter for more than five months. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 18,181.08p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 24,775.17p upto Mar.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 18,181.08p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
