# ORDER (Dt.29.04.2025)

#### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Iradat Khan, Secretary who is a LT-SPP consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Jul.-2024 to Feb.-2025. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

#### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 22.04.2025

#### **SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING**

The complainant is a consumer under Sonepur Section of Sonepur Sub-division. The complainant represented that he has been served with average bills from Jul.-2024 to Feb.-2025 due to meter defective. For that, the total outstanding arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 28,444.33p upto Mar.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

# SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-SPP consumer availing power supply since Jan.-2018. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Jul.-2024 to Feb.-2025 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TWSP51250327 has been installed on 22<sup>nd</sup> Mar. 2025, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

# FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-SPP consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 28<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2018 and total outstanding upto Mar.-2025 is ₹ 28,444.33p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he has been served with average bills from Jul-2024 to Feb.-2025 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. TWSP51250327 on 22<sup>nd</sup> Mar. 2025 and thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter in obedience to OERC Regulation.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than six months. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 28,444.33p upto Mar.-2025.

3. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code-2019 to redress the consumer grievances.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The energy bills raised to the consumer from Jul.-2024 to Feb.-2025 is to be revised as per succeeding six months average consumption of new meter by considering IMR: 0 (22.03.2025) & FMR of Sep.-2025 under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code 2019.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within six months after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
