ORDER (Dt.15.05.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Tusura on 09th May 2025, the representative of the consumer Shri Akshaya Kumar Sahu was present & Shri Sanjib Kumar Padhi, SDO-Tusura was present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Akshaya Kumar Sahu who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 4 KW. He has disputed about the additional bill of ₹ 16,302.17p raised in the bill of Mar.-2025 and requested for bill revision. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 09.05.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Deogaon section of Tusura Sub-division. The complainant represented that an additional bill of ₹ 16,302.17p has been debited in the bill of Mar.-2025 illegally which needs to be withdrawn and requested before the Forum for revision of bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant records. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply prior to Apr-1999. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the additional bill of ₹ 16,302.17p has been raised in Mar.-2025 bill in obedience to Cl-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is liable to pay by the consumer. The reason of additional bill due to average billing made from Jul-2023 to Dec-2023. On 15th jan. 2024, the defective meter has been replaced with a new meter having meter no. TWB307118. After meter replacement, the monthly bills have generated on actual basis. The

additional bill of ₹ 16,302.17p has been raised based on the consumption pattern of succeeding six months and assessed for the meter defective period i.e. from Jul-2023 to Dec-2023.

Based on the above, the OP requested before the Forum to reject the complaint of complainant and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 4 KW. The consumer has availed power supply prior to Apr-1999 and total outstanding upto Apr.-2025 is ₹ 21,740.40p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, an additional bill of ₹ 16,302.17p has been added in the bill of Mar.-2025 which needs to be withdrawn.

The OP submitted by OP with relevant record that, the energy meter installed in the premises was gone defective w.e.f. Jul-2023 and continued with same status till Dec.-2023 billing. The OP has replaced the defective meter with a new meter on 15th Jan. 2024 with meter no. TWB307118 and has been reflected in the bill. Thereafter, the monthly energy bill has been raised on actual meter reading basis. The dispute has raised for imposition of additional bill of ₹ 16,302.17p due to delay replacement of meter by the OP. Off-late, the OP has replaced the meter after six months of meter defective, it is advised the OP to be more pro-active for replacement of defective meter within standard time as prescribed by Hon'ble OERC. In the instant case, the OP has exercised Cl-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 21,740.40p upto Apr.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The additional bill of ₹ 16,302.17p has been raised by the opposite party is in obedience to Cl-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2019 and the complainant is liable to pay the same. Hence, the complaint of the complainant is hereby rejected. The Forum advised the OP to allow suitable installment on the additional bill to the complainant if the complainant desires and the complainant has to adhere the same.

Case is disposed off accordingly.
