HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Gopal Prasad Agrawal who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 5 KW. He has disputed about the provisional & average bill raised from Aug-Sep/2022 to Sep-2024. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 14.05.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-I section of Titilagarh Sub-division. The complainant represented that he has been served with provisional & average bills from Aug-Sep/2022 to Sep-2024. For that disputed bill, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 2,026.14p upto Apr.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Jan.-2014. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the provisional & average billing from Aug-Sep/2022 to Sep-2024 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TWSP51199384 has been installed on 30th Sep. 2024 against that defective meter, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed M. L'Charling bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 22nd Jan. 2014 and total outstanding upto Apr.-2025 is ₹ 2,026.14p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Aug-Sep/2022 to Sep-2024 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. TWSP51199384 on 30th Sep. 2024 and thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than two years. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

2. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code-2019 to redress the consumer grievances.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The energy bills raised to the consumer from Oct-Nov/2022 to Sep-2024 (restricted to two year) is to be revised as per succeeding six months average consumption of new meter by considering IMR: 0 (30.09.2024) & FMR: 679 (Mar-2025) under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code 2019.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
