ORDER (Dt.19.06.2025)

#### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Taria Majhi who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He has disputed about the erroneous bills raised during Sep-2021 to Jul-2023 where the meter was in running condition. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

#### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 18.06.2025

#### SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Saintala section of Saintala Sub-division. The consumer represented that he has been served with erroneous bills during Sep.-2021 to Jul-2023 where the meter was running. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 27,262.90p upto May-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

## SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Nov.-2013. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the erroneous billing from Sep.-2021 to Jul-2023 is a genuine dispute. During the said disputed period, the meter was running but due to erroneous meter status punched by the concerned meter reader, the consumer was billed on average basis. The matter has been detected during Aug-2023 billing and "O" code meter status correction has been done with CMR: 6684. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

# FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 27<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2013 and total outstanding upto May-2025 is ₹ 27,262.90p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. The consumer represented that erroneous billing has been done from Sep.-2021 to Jul-2023 which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to erroneous meter status punched by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed with average basis in stead of meter reading basis. The meter status has been rectified in Aug.-2023 with CMR: 6684. In response to that an additional bill of ₹ 24,628.87p has been raised in Jul-2023 bill month. Thereafter actual billing has been done.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter status for one year & ten months where the meter was running with OK status in the field for which the consumer was raised dispute. Due to delay in resolve the grievances by the OP, average billing was done which could have been avoided for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹24,628.87 (-) ₹21,628.51p = ₹3,000.36p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 27,262.90p upto May-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of  $\stackrel{?}{=}$  24,628.87 (-)  $\stackrel{?}{=}$  21,628.51p =  $\stackrel{?}{=}$  3,000.36p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
