ORDER (Dt.29.07.2025)

The complainant has appealed before the Forum on 02nd Jul. 2025 which has been registered as Case no. 353/2025. The complainant has raised his grievances that an additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29 has been added in the bill of Sep.-2024 illegally which needs to be revised.

Accordingly, hearing date has fixed on 14th Jul. 2025 and notice was served to both the parties to remain present with supportive documents on the said date.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Prasanta Kumar Patel who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1.5 KW. He has disputed about the additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29p raised in the bill of Sep.-2024 and requested for bill revision. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 14.07.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under REC section of Balangir-II Sub-division. The complainant represented that an additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29p has been debited in the bill of Sep.-2024 illegally which needs to be withdrawn and requested before the Forum for revision of bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant records. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply prior to Apr-1999. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29p has been raised in Sep.-2024 bill in obedience to Cl-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is liable to pay by the consumer. The reason of additional bill due to average billing made from Feb.-2015 to Jul-2023, the defective meter has been replaced with a new meter having meter no. TWSP51025685

on 01st Sep. 2023. After meter replacement, the monthly bills have been generated on actual basis. The additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29p has been raised based on the consumption pattern of succeeding six months and assessed for the meter defective period restricted to preceding two year.

Based on the above, the OP requested before the Forum to reject the complaint of complainant and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom, consumer with a CD of 1.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply prior to Apr-1999 and total outstanding upto Jun-2025 is ₹ 44,978.58p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

As represented by the consumer, an additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29p has been added in the bill of Sep-2024 which needs to be withdrawn. The OP submitted with relevant record that, the energy meter installed in the premises has gone defective on Feb.-2015 and continued with same status till Aug.-2023. The OP has replaced the defective meter with a new meter on 01st Aug. 2023 with meter no. TWSP51025685 and has been reflected in the bill. Thereafter, the monthly energy bill has been raised on actual meter reading basis. The dispute was raised for imposition of additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29p due to delay replacement of meter by the OP. Off-late, the OP has replaced the meter after eight years of meter defective which violates Cl-155 of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code-2019 and also attracts under Schedule-III of Guaranteed Standard of Performance of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code. Hence, it is advised the OP to be more pro-active for replacement of defective meter within standard time as prescribed by Hon'ble OERC. In the instant case, the OP has exercised Cl-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The additional bill of ₹ 38,098.29p has been raised by the opposite party in the bill of Sep-2024 is in obedience to Cl-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2019 and the complainant is liable to pay the same. Hence, the complaint of the complainant is hereby rejected. The Forum advised the OP to allow suitable installment on the additional bill to the complainant if the complainant desires and the complainant has to adhere the same.

Case is disposed off accordingly.
