ORDER (Dt.24.07.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Sindhekela Section Office on 16th Jul. 2025, the consumer Shri Kusha Thapa was present & Shri Kalilash Chandra Swain, Dy. Manager (Fin. & Com.) was present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Kusha Thapa who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from the date of supply to Nov.-2020. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 16.07.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Sindhekela section of Titilagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills due to no meter in his premises from the date of power supply to Nov-2020. For that average bill, the arrear amount has been accumulated to ₹24,639.53p upto Jun-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Nov.-2019. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from the date of power supply to Nov-2020 was due to no meter in his premises. A new meter with sl. no. WPM320607 has been installed on 14th Dec. 2020, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated average billing period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 07th Nov. 2019 and total outstanding upto Jun.-2025 is ₹ 24,639.53p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. The consumer has availed power supply without meter from the date of power supply i.e. 07th Nov. 2019 to Nov.-2020 which violates Cl-97 (ii) of OERC Dist. Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is a gross negligence on the part of OP which should not be. The Forum has taken this as a <u>serious note</u> and warned the OP not to repeat such things in future.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter with sl. no. WPM320607 has been installed on 14th Dec. 2020, thereafter actual billing has been done. Due to billing with unmetered status, the consumer was served with average bills from 07th Nov. 2019 to Dec.-2020 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter in obedience to OERC Regulation.

- 2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 24,639.53p upto Jun.-2025.
- 3. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code-2019 to redress the consumer grievances.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The energy bills raised to the consumer from the date of power supply i.e. 07th Nov. 2019 to Dec.-2020 is to be revised as per succeeding six months average consumption of new meter by considering IMR: 0 (14.12.2020) & FMR: 955 (Jun.-2021) under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code 2019.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
