ORDER (Dt.30.07.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Bangomunda on 23<sup>rd</sup> Jul. 2025, the consumer Shri Pramesh Bag was present & Shri Sanjay Tirkey, SDO-Kantabanji was present as opposite party.

### HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Pramesh Bag who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Dec-2018 to Dec-2024. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

## PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 23.07.2025

## SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Kantabanji section of Kantabanji Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Dec.-2018 to Dec-2024 due to meter defective. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 64,728.63p upto Jun.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

### SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Jun.-2013. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Dec-2018 to May-2021 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. LW427926 was installed on 31st May 2021 but again the said meter is found to be defective from the date of meter installation and continued upto Nov.-2024 for which another new meter with sl. no. TWB342324 has been installed on 26th Dec. 2024, thereafter actual billing was done. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision as per Cl-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

### FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 2 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 21<sup>st</sup> Jun. 2013 and total outstanding upto Jun.-2025 is ₹ 64,728.63p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Dec-2018 to Dec-2024 which needs bill revision.



The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter was installed with meter no. LW427926 on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021 but the said meter became defective from the date of installation and continued with same status till Nov-2024. A new meter with sl. no. TWB342324 has been installed on 26<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2024, thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter as per Cl-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than six years which violates Cl-155 of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code-2019 and also attracts under Schedule-III of Guaranteed Standard of Performance of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code. Hence, it is advised the OP to be more pro-active for replacement of defective meter within standard time as prescribed by Hon'ble OERC. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

- 2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 64,728.63p upto Jun.-2025.
- On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code-2019 to redress the consumer grievances.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- The energy bills raised to the consumer from Dec-2022 to Nov.-2024 is to be revised as per succeeding six months average consumption of new meter by considering IMR: 0 (26.12.2024) & FMR: 24 (Jun.-2025) under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code 2019.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.
- 4. The energy bills raised to the consumer from Dec-2022 to Nov.-2024 is to be revised as per succeeding six months average consumption of new meter by considering IMR: 0 (26.12.2024) & FMR: 24 (Jun.-2025) under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code 2019.

5. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.

6. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.
