**(Dt.14.08.2025)**

During Camp Court hearing at Belpada on 12<sup>th</sup> Aug. 2025, the representative of the consumer Shri Subash Chandra Meher was present & Shri Debadatta Mahapatra, SDO-Patnagarh was present as opposite party.

**HISTORY OF THE CASE**

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Subash Chandra Meher who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Dec.-2012 to Dec.-2023. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

**PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED : 12.08.2025**

**SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING**

The complainant is a consumer under Belpada section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Dec-2012 to Dec.-2023 due to meter defective. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 73,993.28p upto Jun.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

**SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING**

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Oct-2006. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Dec-2012 to Dec-2023 was due to meter defective

for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TWB126887 has been installed on 27<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2024, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision as per CI-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

### **FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM**

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 2 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 25<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2006 and total outstanding upto Jun.-2025 is ₹ 73,993.28p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Dec-2012 to Dec-2023 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. TWB126887 on 27<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2024, thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter as per CI-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than eleven years which violates CI-155 of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code-2019 and also attracts under Schedule-III of Guaranteed Standard of Performance of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code. Hence, it is advised the OP to be more pro-active for replacement of defective meter within standard time as prescribed by Hon'ble OERC. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 12,909.96p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 73,993.28p upto Jun.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 12,909.96p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.
