ORDER (Dt.19.08.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Titilagarh division office on 13th Aug. 2025, the representative of the consumer Shri Ranjib Kumar Padhi was present & Shri Binay Kumar Panigrahi, SDO-Titilagarh was present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Ranjib Kumar Padhi who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 3.5 KW. He has disputed about the inflated and erroneous bills raised in Nov-2022 with 299 units. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 13.08.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-I section of Titilagarh Sub-division. The complainant represented that he has been served with erroneous & inflated bill in Nov.-2022 with 299 units. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 2,632.42p upto Jun.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Apr.-2003. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated and erroneous billing in Nov.-2022 with 299 units is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision. No Lalos us

CO-OPTED MEMBER

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 3.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 28th Apr. 2003 and total outstanding upto Jun.-2025 is ₹ 2,632.42p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. The consumer represented that erroneous reading & inflated billing has been done during Nov.-2022 with 299 units which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 1,683.73p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 2,632.42p upto Jun.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 1,683.73p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
