# ORDER (Dt.19.08.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Titilagarh division office on 13<sup>th</sup> Aug. 2025, the representative of the consumer Shri Pankaj Kumar Mediratta was present & Shri Binay Kumar Panigrahi, SDO-Titilagarh was present as opposite party.

### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Pankaj Kumar Mediratta who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 6 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Jun-Jul/2024 to Nov-2024. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

#### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 13.08.2025

#### SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-I section of Titilagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Jun-Jul/2024 to Nov-2024 due to meter defective. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 4,068.60p upto Jul.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

# SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply prior to Apr-1999. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Jun-Jul/2024 to Nov.-2024 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TWSP51218224 has been installed on 18<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2024, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision as per Cl-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

# FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 6 KW. The consumer has availed power supply prior to Apr-1999 and total outstanding upto Jul.-2025 is ₹ 4,068.60p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Jun-Jul/2024 to Nov-2024 which needs bill revision. The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. TWSP51218224 on 18th Dec. 2024, thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter as per Cl-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 5,119.36p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding. Also, the Forum observed that the contract demand of the consumer is 6 KW and availing power supply at single phase which violates Cl-134 (I) (1) (c) of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply Code) 2019 and advised to take necessary step to extend power supply with 3-phase and proper 3-ph metering arrangement.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner has convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 5,119.36p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.
- 2. The OP is advised to take necessary steps to extend power supply at 3-ph instead of 1ph power supply. Necessary estimates to be framed and intimation to be given to the consumer for making payment.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
