ORDER (Dt.26.08.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Subalaya on 21st Aug. 2025, the representative of the consumer Shri Sudarshan Meher was present & Shri Abadhut Pradhan, Asst. Manager (Fin. & Com.) was present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Sudarshan Meher who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed about the average bills raised from Feb-Mar/2001 to Feb-Mar/2002 and erroneous bill raised from Jan-Feb/2014 to Jan-2024. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case has heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 21.08.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Subalaya section of B M Pur Sub-division. The complainant represented that he was served with average bills from Feb-Mar/2001 to Feb-Mar/2002 and erroneous bill from Jan-2014 to Jan-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

He has stated that due to such disputed bill, he has not made regular payment for which the arrear outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 15,529.22p upto Jul-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant documents. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply prior to Apr-1999 and total outstanding upto Jul.-2025 is ₹ 15,529.22p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that.

DDEGIDENT

1. The consumer represented that due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Feb-Mar/2001 to Feb-Mar/2002. The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. 122773 during Apr-2002 and thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 2,401.70p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The consumer represented that erroneous reading & inflated billing has been done from Jan.-2014 to Jan.-2024 which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading. The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 910.40p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 15,529.22p upto Jul.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
