### ORDER (Dt.12.08.2024)

#### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1.5 KW. He has disputed the provisional & average bill raised from Jun/Jul.-2013 to Nov.-2018 due to meter defective. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

## **PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 06.08.2024**

### SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Chatamakhna section of Balangir-II Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with provisional & average bills from Jun/Jul.-2013 to Nov.-2018 due to meter defective. For that, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 35,107.97p upto Jul.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

#### SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Mar.-2012. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the provisional & average billing from Jun/Jul-2013 to Nov.-2018 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. LW067557 has been installed on 17<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2018, thereafter actual billing is going on. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

### FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 31<sup>st</sup> Mar. 2012 and the arrear outstanding upto Jul.-2024 is ₹ 35,107.97p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Jun/Jul.-2013 to Nov.-2018 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. LW067557 on 17<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2018 and thereafter actual billing is going on. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than five years. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 8,525.81p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 35,107.97p upto Jul.-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of  $\stackrel{?}{\stackrel{?}{$\sim}}$  8,525.97p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
