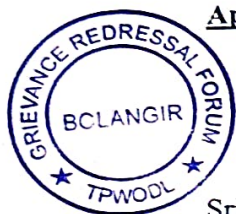

OPPOSITE PARTY

ORDER

(Dt.31.01.2026)

During Camp Court hearing at Charbhata PSS on 22nd Jan. 2026, the representative of the consumer Shri Rasika Padhan was present & Shri Bibekananda Dikshit, SDO-Sonapur was present on behalf of opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Raseeka Padhan who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He has disputed about the inflated and erroneous bills raised from the date of power supply to May-2015. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED : 22.01.2026

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Tarbha section of Sonapur Sub-division. The complainant represented that he has served with erroneous & inflated bills from the date of power supply to May-2015. For that inflated bills, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 9,909.86p upto Dec.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Apr.-2014. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated and erroneous billing from the date of power supply to May-2015 is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 18th Apr. 2014 under DOM category and total outstanding upto Dec.-2025 is ₹ 9,909.86p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,



1. The consumer represented that erroneous reading & inflated billing has been done from the date of power supply to May-2015 which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to suppressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 3,999.22p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

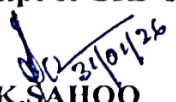
2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 9,909.86p upto Dec.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 3,999.22p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
