HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by Shri Mukesh Meher who is LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1.5 KW. He has disputed the average bills raised from Aug-2015 to Jul-2020 with defective meter. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED : 22.08.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under REC section of Balangir-II Sub-division. The consumer represented that he has received energy bill with defective meter from Aug-2015 to Jul-2020. For that, the arrear has accumulated to ₹ 26,813 58p upto Jul.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Dec-2001. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Aug-2015 to Jul-2020 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. LW593674 has been installed on 19th Jul. 2020, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 03rd Dec. 2001 and the arrear outstanding upto Jul.-2024 is ₹ 26,813 58p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. Due to meter defective, the consumer was served with average bills from Aug-2015 to Jul-2020 with meter no. 133898A resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.
2. A new meter has been installed by OP with meter no. LW593674 on 19th Jul. 2020, thereafter actual billing has been done. In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for five years. In the above case, due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP was installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to take some pro-active measure for early replacement of defective meter.
3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 26,813.58p upto Jul.-2024.
4. The OP has submitted that as the disputed billing period has not yet revised, it needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.
5. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under CI-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 to redress the consumer grievances. However, during the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 23,705.72p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.




In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code'2019.

The OP has re-calculated the bill and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 23,705.72p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
