ORDER (Dt.14.11.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Ghumer on 12th Nov. 2025, the consumer Shri Pitambar Bhoi was present & Shri Debadatta Mohapatra, SDO-Patnagarh was present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Pitambar Bhoi who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.5 KW. He has disputed about the inflated and erroneous bills raised in Jun.-2023 with 384 units. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 12.11.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-III section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The complainant represented that he has served with erroneous & inflated bill in Jun-2013 with 384 units. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 12,416.32p upto Oct-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Nov-2012. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated and erroneous billing in Jun-2023 with 384 units is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter reader to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 01st Nov. 2012 under DOM category and total outstanding upto Oct-2025 is ₹ 12,416.32p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that.

1. The consumer represented that erroneous reading & inflated billing was done in Jun.-2023 with 384 units which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to suppressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 1,732.04p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 12,416.32p upto Oct.-2025.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 1,732.04p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
