ORDER (Dt.12.09.2024)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He has disputed about the erroneous and average bills raised from the date of supply to Jan-2021 due to no meter in his premises. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 23.08.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Agalpur section of Loisinga Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills due to without meter from the date of supply to Jan-2021. For that average bills, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 20724.00 upto Jul.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant records. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Oct-2018. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from the date of supply to Jan-2021 was due to without meter in his premises as this is given under soubhagya scheme. As the above-stated average billing period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 20th Oct-18 and the arrear outstanding upto Jul.-2024 is ₹ 20724.00. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. The consumer has availed power supply without meter from the date of supply to Jan-2021 which violates Cl-97 (ii) of OERC Dist. Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is a gross negligence on the part of OP which should not be. The Forum has taken this as a <u>serious note</u> and warned the OP not to repeat such things in future.
- A new meter with sl. no. LW505118 has been installed on Dt.12.01.21, thereafter
 actual billing has been done. Due to billing without meter, the consumer was served
 with average bills from the date of supply to Dec.-2020 resulting accumulation of
 arrear outstanding.
- 3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has been accumulated to is ₹ 20724.00 upto Jul.-2024.
- 4. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during without meter period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code-2019 to redress the consumer grievances. However, during the course of hearing, the opposite party admitted the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has recalculated with the consumption and an amount of Rs.13009.40ps is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The opposite party was recalculated the bill and the Complainant was convinced with the proposed withdrawal of Rs.13009.40ps. Hence, the Forum directed the opposite party to carry out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
