#### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

The Complaint petition filed by Baima Biwi who is LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1.7 KW. She has disputed the average bills raised from Jan-Feb/2009 to Oct-2013 for defective meter. She has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 28.08.2024

#### SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Khaprakhol section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he has received energy bill with defective meter from Jan-Feb/2009 to Oct-2013. For that, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 21,655.06p upto Jul.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

# SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Nov.-2002. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Jan-Feb/2009 to Oct-2013 was due to meter

defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. 2744734 has been installed during Nov.-2013, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

#### FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1.7 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 17<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2002 and the arrear outstanding upto Jul.-2024 is ₹ 21,655.06p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

 Due to meter defective, the consumer was served with average bills from Jan-Feb/2009 to Oct-2013 with meter no. 1813498 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.



- 2. A new meter has been installed by OP with meter no. 2744734 during Nov.-2013, thereafter actual billing has been done. In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than four years. In the above case, due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP was installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to take some pro-active measure for early replacement of defective meter.
- 3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 21,655.06p upto Jul.-2024.
- 4. The OP has submitted that as the disputed billing period has not yet revised, it needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.
- 5. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 to redress the consumer grievances. However, during the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 12,653.40p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code'2019.

The OP has re-calculated the bill and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 12,658.40p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

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Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
