HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Gangadhar Saha who is LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He was disputed the erroneous and inflated bills raised in Jun-2023 with 895 units. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

#### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 28.08.2024

#### SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Khaprakhol section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The complainant represented that he was served with erroneous & inflated bills in Jun.-2023 with 895 units. For that, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 11,033.66p upto Jul.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

## SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with billing ledger from Jan.-2019 to Jul-2024. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Oct. 2018. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated billing done in the month of Jun-2023 is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

## FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 27<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2018 and the arrear outstanding upto Jul.-2024 is ₹ 11,033.66p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. The consumer represented that erroneous reading & inflated billing was done in the month of Jun.-2023 with 895 units which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 3,028.56p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has accumulated to ₹ 11,033.66p upto Jul.-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code'2019.

The OP has recasted the energy bill and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of  $\stackrel{?}{\stackrel{?}{\stackrel{?}{$\sim$}}}$  3,028.56p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
