ORDER
(Dt.10.03.2026)

During Camp Court hearing at Jarasingha PSS on 17th Feb. 2026, the representative of the consumer Shri Rohit Kumar Podh was present & Shri Narottam Maharana, SDO-Tusura was present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition has filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Rohit Kumar Podh who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.11 KW. The complainant represented that an additional bill of ₹ 3,765.41p has been debited in the bill of Oct-2025 illegally which needs to be withdrawn and requested before the Forum for revision of bill.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED : 17.02.2026

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Tusura Section of Tusura Sub-division. The complainant represented that an additional bill of ₹ 3,765.41p has been debited in the bill of Oct-2025 illegally which needs to be withdrawn and requested before the Forum for revision of bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Apr.-2017. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the additional bill of ₹ 3,765.41p has been raised in Oct-2025 bill in obedience to CI-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is liable to pay by the consumer. The reason of additional bill raised due to average billing made from Aug.-2019 to Feb.-2025 due to meter defective. On 31st Mar. 2025, the defective meter has been replaced with a new meter having meter no. TWB352221. After meter replacement, the monthly bills have been generated on actual basis. The additional bill of ₹ 3,765.41p has been raised based on the consumption pattern of succeeding six months and assessed for the meter defective period restricted for a period of preceding two year.

Based on the above, the OP requested before the Forum to reject the complaint of complainant and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.11 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 28th Apr. 2017 and total outstanding upto Jan-2026 is ₹ 5,303.26p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

As represented by the consumer, an additional bill of ₹ 3,765.41p has been added in the bill of Oct-2025 which needs to be withdrawn. The OP submitted with relevant record that, the energy meter installed in the premises was gone defective w.e.f. Aug.-2019 and continue with same status till Feb-2025. The OP has replaced the defective meter with a new meter on 31st Mar. 2025 with meter no. TWB352221 and has been reflected in the bill. Thereafter, the monthly energy bill has been raised on actual meter reading basis. The dispute has raised for imposition of additional bill of ₹ 3,765.41p was due to delay replacement of meter by the OP. Off-late, the OP has replaced the meter after five years & six months of meter defective which violates Cl-155 of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code-2019 and also attracts under Schedule-III of Guaranteed Standard of Performance of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code. Hence, it is advised the OP to be more pro-active for replacement of defective meter within standard time as prescribed by Hon'ble OERC. In the instant case, the OP has exercised Cl-155 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

During the course of hearing, the OP admitted with the billing complaints and intimated that they have initiated re-assessment of upward assessment observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the re-assessed amount has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 2,743.25p is to be debited and ₹ 3,765.41p which was debited in the bill of Oct-2025 is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has initiated the re-assessment of upward assessed amount and the petitioner has convinced with the proposal. Accordingly, the re-assessed amount of ₹ 2,743.25p is to be debited and the upward assessment of ₹ 3,765.41p which was debited in the bill of Oct-2025 is to be withdrawn. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
