**HISTORY OF THE CASE** 

The Complainant Shri Pradip Naik, representative of the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1.5 KW. He has disputed about the erroneous and average bills raised from the date of supply to Feb.-2010 due to no meter in his premises. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 07.10.2024

#### SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under REC section of Sub-division-II, Balangir. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills due to no meter from the date of supply to Feb.-2010. For that average bills, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 1,00,328.16p upto Aug.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

# **SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING**

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant records. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Feb.-2001. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from the date of supply to Feb.-2010 was due to no meter in his premises. As the above-stated average billing period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

# FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 10<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2001 and the arrear outstanding upto Aug.-2024 is ₹ 1,00,328.16p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. The consumer was availed power supply without meter from the date of supply i.e. 10<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2001 to Feb.-2010 which violates Cl-97 (ii) of OERC Dist. Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 which is a gross negligence on the part of OP which should not be. The Forum has taken this as a <u>serious note</u> and warned the OP not to repeat such things in future.
- 2. A new meter with sl. no. 343928 has been installed during Mar.-2010, thereafter actual billing has been done. Due to billing with unmetered status, the consumer was served with average bills from the date of supply to Feb.-2010 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.



3. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the average bills raised during no meter period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 to redress the consumer grievances. However, during the course of hearing, the OP has agreed with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 2,293.08p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has re-calculated the bill and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 2,293.08p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
