ORDER (Dt.29.10.2024)

During spot hearing at Agalpur consumer camp on dt.21.10.2024 the Complainant Sri Jagannath Padhan appeared before the Forum in person and Sri Abanikanta Maharana, S.D.O (Elect.), TPWODL, Loisingha appeared as opposite party.

The Complainant bearing consumer no. 911312051671 in his written petition disputed the average billings raised during the period from March'2023 to May'2023. He therefore requested before the Forum to settle up the issue by way of a suitable bill revision.

On the other hand the opposite party submitted a billing statement pertaining to the period from May-June'2019 to September'2024. He admitted to the facts stated by the Complainant and also requested the Forum to do the needful as deemed fit in this regard.

The Forum after going through all the relevant records placed before it observed that;

- 1. The CD of the premises is 0.5 KW under domestic load having initial power supply being given under Soubhagya Scheme.
- 2. Actual basis bills were seen to have been done with some intermittent provisional bills being duly adjusted.
- 3. But average basis bills were done from March'2023 to May'2023 having not being adjusted/revised as per norms.
- 4. The defective meter bearing no. 3161258 has been replaced with a new one having Sl. No. TWO204763J during May'2023 i.e. on dt.16.05.2023.
- 5. The Forum is therefore of the opinion for revision of bills as per norms of the regulation.

The opposite party also admitted the billing dispute for the aforesaid period and initiated the bill revision process on spot observing all departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly

bills were recalculated with the consumption and an amount of Rs.803.71ps is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstandings. The Complainant was also convinced with the proposed withdrawal of Rs.803.71ps from the arrear bill.

Basing on above observations, Forum passes the following direction as per Regulation of QERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The opposite party is directed to carry out the revision proposal concerning to the period from March'2023 to May'2023 with IMR '06' Kwh (IMR of June'2023) and FMR '068' (CMR of November'2023) with a withdrawal amount of Rs.803.71ps which is to be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
