ORDER (Dt.12.11.2024)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Bidyadhar Naik who is a LT-GPS consumer availing a CD of 5 KW. He has disputed about the inflated and erroneous bills raised in Aug-Sep/2022 with 9312 units. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 08.11.2024

# SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Subalaya section of B M Pur Sub-division. The complainant represented that he was served with erroneous & inflated bill in Sep-Oct/2022 with 9312 units. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 90,246.86p upto Sep.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

# SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-GPS consumer availing power supply since Sep.-2016. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated and erroneous billing in Sep-Oct/2022 with 9312 units is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

## FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-GPS consumer with a CD of 5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 11<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2016 and total outstanding upto Sep.-2024 is ₹ 90,246.86p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. The consumer represented that erroneous reading & inflated billing was done in the month of Sep-Oct/2022 with 9312 units which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 11,978.20p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding. However, a bill revision has been done in the month of Sep.-2003 with a credit of ₹ 6,499.28p which needs to be taking into account as the same billing period again revised. Hence, a net amount of ₹ 5,478.92p (₹ 11,978.20p - ₹ 6,499.28p) is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 90,3246.86p upto Sep.-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 5,478.92p (₹ 11,978.20p - ₹ 6,499.28p). Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
