ORDER (Dt.12.11.2024)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Pranabandhu Sanyasi who is a LT-Dom consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Oct-Nov/2009 to Jan-Feb/2021. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 08.11.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Ullunda section of B M Pur Sub-division. The complainant represented that he was served with average bill from Oct-Nov/2009 to jan-Feb/2021 due to meter defective. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 56,374.93p upto Oct.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Aug.-2004. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Oct-Nov/2009 to Jan-Feb/2021 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. LW590028 has been installed on 26th Feb. 2020 but due to protocol delay, it has been reflected in Mar.-2022, thereafter actual billing is going on. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 2 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 29th Aug. 2004 and the total outstanding upto Oct.-2024 is ₹ 56,374.93p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

Due to meter defective, the consumer was served with average bills from Oct-Nov/2009 to Jan-Feb/2021 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding. A new meter has been installed by OP with meter no. LW590028 on 26th Feb. 2020 but due to delay in updation of meter protocol data, the meter data has been captured in Mar.-2022.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than eleven years. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has agreed with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill was recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 36,654.09p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 56,374.93p upto Oct.-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 36,654.09p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
