HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complainant is a Domestic. consumer availing a CD of 2.0 KW_. He has disputed the average bill raised from Dec-23 to July-24. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill in GRF camp at Thakpada and heard at spot. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 10.12.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Patnagarh II Section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Dec-23 to July-24 due to defective meter billing. For such, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹.3875.56p upto Nov-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant document. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a Domestic consumer availing power supply since March-14. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Dec-23 to July-24 due to defective meter supply. A new meter with sl. no. TWB159426 has been installed in Dt.24.08.2024 and thereafter actual billing is going on. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a Dom consumer with a CD of 2.0 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 16th Mar-2014 and the arrear outstanding to ₹.3875.56p upto Nov-2024. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. Due to defective meter, the consumer was served with average bills from Dec-23 to July-24, resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.
- 2. A new meter has been installed by OP with meter no. Sl. no. TWB159426 on Dt.24.08.2024, thereafter actual billing has done.
- 3. The OP has submitted that as the disputed billing period has not yet revised, it needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.
- 4. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code-2019 to redress the consumer grievances.
- 5. Matter was discussed in details with both parties and OP agreed to revise the bills taking into consideration avg. consumption of new meter and complainant agreed to pay.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The energy bills raised to the consumer from Dec-23 to July-24 should be revised as per succeeding six months average consumption of new meter considering IMR '0' (IMR on dt.24.08.2024) & FMR of Feb-2025 under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code 2019.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within three months after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
