HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the consumer Shri Annanda Chandra Pattnaik who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He was disputed about the provisional bills raised from Aug-2016 to Mar-2017. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 13.12.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-Salebhata section of Loisingha Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with provisional bills in his premises from Aug.-2016 to Mar-2017 which has not been adjusted subsequently. For that provisional bill, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 3,22,504.67p upto Nov.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant records. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply prior to Apr-1999. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the provisional billing from Aug-2016 to Mar-2017 was due to defective meter in his premises. A new meter with sl. no. WUS28090 was installed during Apr-2017, thereafter actual billing was done. As the above-stated average billing period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply prior to Apr-1999 and total outstanding upto Nov.-2024 is ₹ 3,22,504.67p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. As represented by the consumer, due to provisional billing, he was served with provisional bills from Aug.-2016 to Mar.-2017 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that a new meter has been installed with meter no. WUS28090 during Apr. 2017 and thereafter actual billing has been done. The provisional billing period which has not been adjusted needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than seven months. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of \P 9,309.75p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the total has been accumulated to ₹ 3,22,504.67p upto Nov.-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 9,309.75p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
