HISTORY OF THE CASE

The complaint was received at Camp court conducted at Dhumabhata on dated 17<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2024. The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Bharat Meher who is a LT-GPS. consumer availing a CD of 3 KW. He was disputed that he was availed power supply under LT-DOM. Category but bill has been raised on GPS category since Dec04/Jan05. He was submitted his grievances for revision of bill under GPS tariff from Dec04/Jan05. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

#### PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 17.12.2024

## SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Belpada section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he has availed power supply under LT-Dom. Category but bill has been generated on GPS category since Dec04/Jan05 which needs bill revision under Domestic tariff. For that, the arrear has been accumulated to ₹ 2,63,329.98p upto Nov.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with billing ledger pertaining to the period from Jan-2003 to Nov-2024. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Nov.-2002. The billing dispute raised by the complainant regarding billing under GPS tariff requires field verification as the matter is very old and asked for seven day time, is not true rather he is being billed under DOM category. As per report of ESO-Chudapali dated 18<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2024, the consumer is using power supply for agriculture purpose and submitted for change of tariff from DOM category to LT-Irr. Pumping & agriculture tariff.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum to allow 7 days time.

#### FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-GPS. consumer with a CD of 3 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 16<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2002 and the arrear outstanding upto Nov.-2024 is ₹ 2,63,329.98p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

The consumer represented that he has availed power supply under LT-Dom tariff category but erroneously bill has been generated & served under GPS tariff since Dec04/Jan05 billing month which needs bill revision as per LT-Dom. tariff from Dec04/Jan05.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted the PVR dated 30.12.2024 that as per field verification & certification of neighbors, there is no commercial activity since Jan-2012. The report submitted by the OP has taken into record. Based on the PVR, the OP submitted for change of tariff from GPS to DOM.

The Forum analysed the documents submitted by both the parties. It is observed that the consumer was availed power supply under LT-Dom tariff category but thereafter amended to LT-GPS tariff since Dec04/Jan05. The consumer was unable to produce any application submitted before the licensee till date. On the other side, after lapse of nineteen years, the claim of consumer for change of tariff category is not acceptable. However, the OP inspected the premises and certified that there is no commercial activity since Jan-2012.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The energy bills raised to the consumer from Dec.-2022 to Nov.-2024 (restricted to two year) under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Distribution Code 2019 is to be revised under LT-Dom tariff category.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
