HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition filed by the representative of the consumer Smt. Sebati Ratei who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. She was disputed about the inflated and erroneous bills raised many occasions between Apr-2020 to Apr-2021. She was filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 18.12.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-II section of Titilagarh Sub-division. The complainant represented that he was served with erroneous & inflated bill from Apr-2020 to Apr-2021. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 5,288.06p upto Nov.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant records. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Mar.-2019. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated and erroneous billing in between Apr-2020 to Apr-2021 is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 14th Mar. 2019 and total outstanding upto Nov.-2024 is ₹ 5,288.06p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. The consumer represented that erroneous reading & inflated billing was done in between Apr-2020 to Apr-2021 which needs bill revision as per actual meter reading.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the above-stated period, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. Hence, to resolve the consumer grievances, the meter reading should be recasted as per TPWODL guidelines.

The Forum analysed the consumption pattern submitted by the OP and observed that the submission of the complainant is based on facts and needs bill revision. The inflated billing months are,

MONTH	BILLED UNITS
Apr-20	596
Oct-20	100
Jan-21	200

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 1,292.95p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has accumulated to ₹ 5,288.06p upto Nov.-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP was agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 1,292.95p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.
