ORDER (Dt.29.01.2024)

During spot hearing at Tarbha consumer camp on dt.05.12.2023 the Complainant Sri Sashi Bhusan Kheti appeared before the Forum in person whereas Sri Bibekananda Dikshit, S.D.O (Elect.), TPWODL, Sonepur appeared as opposite party.

The Complainant bearing consumer no. 9151 0312 0029 in his written petition dt.05.12.2023 i.e. during a GRF camp conducted at "Tarbha" disputed the average basis billings done and on abnormal consumption of 6482 units in the monthly bill of August'2021 which has resulted accumulation of arrear to the tune of Rs.107022/- by month ending October'2023. He therefore requested before the Forum to sortout the issue by way of an appropriate bill revision.

On the other hand the opposite party submitted a billing abstract concerning to the period from January'2011 to October'2023 and admitted the facts stated by the Complainant. He also requested the Forum to do the needful in this regard as deemed fit.

The Forum after going through the records produced before it observed that;

1. The CD of the premises is 0.5 KW having domestic load.

2. Bills on actual basis have been raised with some intermittent provisional and average bills against meter bearing no. 986567.

3. A new meter with Sl. No. LW221343 has been replaced during February'2019 on raising of average and provisional bills from May'2022. But an abnormal consumption of 6482 units is seen to be there during August'2021 which requires a revision. Also there is provisional and average billings from May-June'2022 to November'2023.

4. The opposite party has failed to submit a PVR as directed in course of hearing.

Basing on above observations, Forum passes the following direction as per Regulation of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

1. A new meter is to be installed immediately.

2. The provisional and average bills from May'2022 to till replacement of the new meter are to be revised after obtaining average monthly consumption of subsequent six months of the new meter.

3. As regards to the abnormal consumption of 6482 units during August'2021, the bills are to be recasted from the date of last meter installation i.e. from February'2019 to August'2021 with IMR '01' (IMR of February'2019) and FMR '6712' (CMR of August'2021).

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within seven nonths after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
