### ORDER (Dt.23.02.2024)

#### **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

BOLANGIR

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.4 KW. He has disputed the inflated bill raised in Feb-2022 with 2563 unit, Jun-2023 with 955 units & Sep-2023 with 630 units. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

## PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 06.02.2024

# SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Belpada section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with inflated bill in Feb-2022 with 2563 units, Jun-2023 with 955 units & Sep-2023 with 630 units. For such, the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 23,196.20p upto Jan.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

#### SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with billing abstract. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Sep-2019. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated billing done in the month of Feb-2022 with 2563 units. Jun-2023 with 955 units & Sep-2023 with 630 units is genuine. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter reader to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed

bills and pass order as deemed fit.

# FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.4 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 19<sup>th</sup> Jul. 2019 and the arrear outstanding upto Jan-2024 is ₹. 23,196.20p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. Due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the preceding months, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. This has been detected in the month of Feb-2022, Jun-2023 & Sep-2023 billing and the unbilled units has been billed in the said month. Due to such bill, the arrear amount has accumulated.
- 2. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 23,196.20p upto Jan.-2024.
- 3. During the course of hearing, the OP has agreed with the billing complaints and initiated the bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has recasted with the consumption and a net amount of ₹. 10,213.77p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has recasted the bill and the petitioner has convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹. 10,213.77p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
