## ORDER (Dt.27.02.2024)

#### HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 1 KW. He has disputed about the erroneous and average bills raised from Nov-Dec/2002 to Apr-2016 due to meter defective. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

## **PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 12.02.2024**

#### SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Muribahal section of Kantabanji Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills due to meter defective from Nov-Dec/2002 to Apr-2016. For such average bills, the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 52,258.61p upto Jan-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

#### SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum without relevant documents. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Jan.-2002. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Nov-Dec/2002 to Apr-2016 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. WCV44383 has been installed during May-2016, thereafter actual billing was done. As the above-stated average billing period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed

bills and pass order as deemed fit.

## FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 1 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 28<sup>th</sup> Jan.-2002 and the arrear outstanding upto Jan-2024 is ₹. 52,258.61p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. Due to meter defective, the consumer was served with average bills from Nov-Dec/2002 to Apr-2016 with meter no. 1910427 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.
- 2. A new meter has been installed by OP with meter no. WCV44383 during May-2016 and thereafter actual billing has done. In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than fourteen years. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing has done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.
- 3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 52,258.61p upto Jan-2024.
- 4. The OP has submitted that as the disputed billing period has not yet revised, it needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.
- 5. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 to redress the consumer grievances.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The energy bills raised to the consumer from May-2014 to Apr-2016 are to be revised as per succeeding six months average consumption of new meter by considering IMR: 145 (Jun-2016) & FMR: 615 (Nov-2016) under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. Code 2019.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
