HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed the average bill raised from Nov-Dec/2008 to Sep-2019 due to meter defective. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 12.02.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Muribahal section of Kantabanji Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Nov-Dec/2008 to Sep.-2019 due to meter defective. For such, the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 83,223.13p upto Jan.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum without relevant documents. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply prior to Apr.-1999. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Nov-Dec/2008 to Sep-2019 is due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TW067189 has been installed on 24th Feb. 2019 but due to protocol delay, the KWH parameter has been captured in Oct.-2019 billing with CMR: 150, thereafter actual billing is going on. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 2 KW. The consumer has availed power supply prior to Apr-1999 and the arrear outstanding upto Jan.-2024 is ₹. 83,223.13p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. Due to meter defective, the consumer was served with average bills from Nov-Dec/2008 to Sep-2019 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.

- 2. A new meter has been installed by OP with meter no. LW067189 on 24th Feb. 2019 but due to delay in updation of meter protocol data, the KWH reading has been captured on Oct-2019 with CMR: 150. Accordingly, delay meter updation revision has been done in Mar-2023 bill with credit of ₹. 11,098.50p for the period 24.02.2019 to 05.03.2023.
- 3. In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than ten years. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

4. The OP has submitted that as the disputed billing period has not yet revised, it needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.

5. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 to redress the consumer grievances.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

- 1. The energy bills raised to the consumer from Mar-2017 to Feb-2019 are to be revised as per succeeding months average consumption of new meter by considering IMR: 0 (24.02.2019) & FMR: 150 (Oct-2019) under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.
- 2. DPS is to be levied as per OERC Regulation.
- 3. All sundries and adjustments are to be considered during the above revision period.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
