ORDER (Dt.11.06.2024)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.5 KW. He has disputed the inflated bill raised in Dec.-2023 with 350 units. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 03.06.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-Belpada Section of Patnagarh Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with inflated bill in Dec.-2023 with 350 units. For that, the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 10,885.14p upto Apr.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum without relevant documents. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Jun.-2014. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated billing done in the month of Dec.-2023 with 350 units is genuine. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed

bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 17th Jun. 2014 and the arrear outstanding upto Apr-2024 is ₹. 10,885.14p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. Due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in the preceding months, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. This has been identified during Dec-2023 billing and the unbilled units of 350 units has been billed in Dec-2023. Due to such bill, the arrear amount has accumulated.
- 2. The present meter with sl. No. LW429880 has been installed on 27th Oct. 2019 and is operation till date.
- 3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 10,885.14p upto Apr.-2024.
- 4. During the course of hearing, the OP has agreed with the billing complaints and initiated the bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has recasted with the consumption and a net amount of ₹. 6,420.54p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has recasted the bill and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹. 6,420.54p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal which must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
