HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed about average bills raised from Oct-2015 to Jul-2023. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

## PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 10.07.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Kantabanji Section of Kantabanji Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Oct-2015 to Jul-2023 due to meter defective. For that, the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 2,90,726.35p upto Jun.-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Nov.-1999. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Oct-2015 to Jul-2023 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. TWSP51047338 has been installed on 15<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2023, thereafter actual billing has done. As the above-stated period bill has not revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

## FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 2 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 30<sup>th</sup> Nov. 1999 and the arrear outstanding upto Jun.-2024 is ₹. 2,90,726.35p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

- 1. Due to meter defective, the consumer was served with average bills from Oct-2015 to Jul-2023 with meter no. 804623 which was installed during Aug.-2011 resulting accumulation of arrear outstanding.
- 2. A new meter has been installed by OP with meter no. TWSP51047338 on 15<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2023, thereafter actual billing has been done. In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than seven years. In the above case, due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP was installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.
- 3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 2,90,726.35p upto Jun.-2024.
- 4. The OP has submitted that as the disputed billing period has not yet revised, it needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter.
- 5. On scrutiny of the documents, it is observed by the Forum that the bills raised during meter defective period needs bill revision under Cl-155 & 157 of OERC Dist. (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019 to redress the consumer grievances. However, during the course of hearing, the OP has agreed with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹. 19,820.35p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has re-calculated the bill and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹. 19,820.35p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
