ORDER (Dt.20.06.2024)

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complainant is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 0.5 KW. He has disputed the inflated bills raised in Sep-2016 with 2789 units & Jul-2022 with 1002 units. He has submitted his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case was heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED: 18.06.2024

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under ESO-Muribahal Section of Kantabanji Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with inflated bills in Sep-2016 with 2789 units and Jul-2022 with 1002 units. For that, the arrear was accumulated to ₹. 19,732.80p upto May-2024. The complainant raised dispute against the said bill and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant documents. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Domestic consumer availing power supply since Mar-2001. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the inflated billing for the month of Sep-2016 & Jul-2022 with 2789 units & 1002 units is a genuine dispute. This has happened due to suppressed meter reading done by concerned meter to prevent actual billing in the previous months. As the above-stated period bill has not been revised, it needs bill revision.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 0.5 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 06th Mar. 2001 and the arrear outstanding upto May-2024 is ₹. 19,732.80p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

1. Due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in past months, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. This has been identified in the month of Sep-2016 billing and the unbilled units has been billed in the said month. Due to such bill, the arrear amount was accumulated.

During the course of hearing, the OP has agreed with the billing complaints and initiated the bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recasted with the consumption and a net amount of ₹. 4,956.82p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

- 2. Similarly, due to supressed meter reading by the concerned meter reader in past months, the consumer was billed less units than his actual consumption. This has been identified in the month of Jul-2022 billing and the unbilled units has been billed in the said month. Due to such bill, the arrear amount has accumulated. During the course of hearing, the OP has agreed with the billing complaints and initiated the bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recasted with the consumption and a net amount of ₹. 2,369.71p is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.
- 3. The complainant has not paid the monthly bill regularly for which the arrear has accumulated to ₹. 19,732.80p upto May-2024.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed total withdrawal amount of \mathbb{Z} . 7,326.53p (\mathbb{Z} 4,956.82p + \mathbb{Z} 2,369.71p). Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
