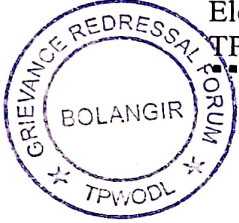

ORDER
(Dt.06.09.2025)

During Camp Court hearing at Cherupali on 04th Sep. 2025, the representative of the consumer Shri Kishor Biswal was present & Shri Uday Sankar Patjoshi, SDO-Binka was present as opposite party.

HISTORY OF THE CASE

The Complaint petition has filed by the representative of the consumer Shri Kishor Biswal who is a LT-Dom. consumer availing a CD of 2 KW. He has disputed about the average bill raised from Sep-Oct/2017 to Jul-Aug/2019. He has filed his grievances for revision of bill. The complainant needs suitable bill revision for the said period.

The case has heard in detail.

PROCEEDING OF HEARING DATED : 04.09.2025

SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINANT DURING HEARING

The complainant is a consumer under Cherupali section of Binka Sub-division. The consumer represented that he was served with average bills from Sep-Oct/2017 to Jul-Aug/2019 due to meter defective. For that, the total outstanding has been accumulated to ₹ 12,916.23p upto Jul.-2025. The complainant raised dispute against the said period and requested before the Forum for suitable revision of the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY DURING HEARING

The OP appeared before the Forum with relevant record. On defence, he intimated that the consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer availing power supply since Nov.-2010. The billing dispute raised by the complainant for the average billing from Sep-Oct/2017 to Jul-Aug/2019 was due to meter defective for that period. A new meter with sl. no. LW249619 has been installed on 31st Jul. 2019, thereafter actual billing has been done. As the above-stated period bill has not yet revised, it needs bill revision as per CI-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

Considering the above, the OP requested before the Forum for revision of previous disputed bills and pass order as deemed fit.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS OF THE FORUM

The consumer is a LT-Dom. consumer with a CD of 2 KW. The consumer has availed power supply since 05th Nov. 2010 and total outstanding upto Jul.-2025 is ₹ 12,916.23p. As complained by the complainant and submission of OP, it is observed by the Forum that,

As represented by the consumer, due to meter defective, he was served with average bills from Sep-Oct/ 2017 to Jul-Aug/2019 which needs bill revision.

The OP admitted the complaint and submitted that due to meter defective, the consumer was billed with average status from Sep-Oct/ 2017 to Jul-Aug/2019. Against that defective meter, a new meter has been installed with meter no. LW249619 on 31st Jul. 2019, thereafter actual billing has been done. The defective billing period needs bill revision as per consumption of new meter as per CI-155 of OERC Regulation (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

In the instant case, it is surprised that the OP has allowed the consumer to continue with defective meter for more than two years which violates CI-155 of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code-2019 and also attracts under Schedule-III of Guaranteed Standard of Performance of OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code. Hence, it is advised the OP to be more pro-active for replacement of defective meter within standard time as prescribed by Hon'ble OERC. Due to delay in installation of new meter, average billing was done which could have been avoided if the OP has installed the meter without delay for which it is advised to the OP to be taken care in future.

During the course of hearing, the OP has admitted with the billing complaints and initiated bill revision process on the spot observing departmental guidelines. Accordingly, the monthly bill has been recalculated with the consumption and an amount of ₹ 3,534.47 is to be withdrawn from the arrear outstanding.

In view of above facts and circumstances and after going through the documents submitted by both the parties, the Forum pronounces the following order as per regulations of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code 2019.

The OP has agreed with the billing dispute and revised the bill on spot and the petitioner was convinced with the proposed withdrawal amount of ₹ 3,534.47p. Hence, the Forum directed the OP to carry-out the revision proposal and must be reflected in the next bill.

Case is disposed off accordingly.

Compliance report must be submitted to the Forum by the opposite party within one month after receipt of GRF order otherwise it will be treated as non-compliance.
