GIST OF THE CASE

The Complainant has filed the petition in the name of Rabi Narayan Nayak bearing Consumer No **4110-0103-0734** under SED, TPWODL, Sambalpur stated about billing dispute-presently the supply is disconnected since of of sand request for reconnection of p/s.

Hence, the Complainant prayed before the Forum to consider the case for revision/rectification and reconnection of p/s.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has not submitted anything in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in records (FG data base and Samadhan App) and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-IPA consumer as seen from the FG data base. The complainant has claimed that the p/s at present is in disconnection position and the disconnection is continuing since of of since of of seen taken on 26.07.2024 at Office of ESO, Chipilima in presence of both parties. The opposite party during hearing objected on the disconnection period of of of sand discussed with this Forum with prayer to allow for verification and enquiry on the above issues as well as assured to revise the bill as per outcome of the enquiry report. Further, the complainant has asked for NSC but after discussion agreed to reconnect the above p/s with clearance of dues after revision thereon.

Hence, the Forum is in the opinion that as the opposite party is liable to revise the bill as per outcome of the enquiry report as committed during hearing where the enquiry to be conducted in presence of the complainant to avoid further litigation. Further, the above p/s to be reconnected only clearance of the outstanding amount dues after revision and receiving DCRC fees also. The complainant is supposed to clear the dues as claimed by opposite party after revision to avail the p/s with reconnection facilities by paying DCRC fees also.

ORDER

Considering the documents and statements submitted by both the parties at the time of hearing, the Forum hereby passes orders that:

1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill of the consumer as per outcome of the enquiry report as committed during hearing where the enquiry to be conducted in presence of the complainant to avoid further litigation. Further, the above p/s to be reconnected only clearance of the outstanding amount dues after revision and receiving DCRC fees also.

- 2. The Complainant is directed to clear the dues as claimed by opposite party after revision to avail the p/s with reconnection facilities by paying DCRC fees also.
- 3. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.
