

GIST OF THE CASE

Chaturbhuja Bhainsal appeared in the hearing on Dt. 08.08.2024 at the camp held at SDO Office, Rengali and submitted a written complaint wherein he has stated that "average bills were served to his borewell from Feb 2015 wherein his actual consumption is Rs.200.00 per month only" & has request to revise/rectify the wrong billing.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has not submitted any relevant document in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-IPA consumer having CD of 2.5KW with date of initial power supply on Dt.07.04.2015 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute as mentioned in GIST with prayer to revise the bill. The power supply was effected without meter & billing were raised on complainant by opposite party on Avg/PL basis since the date of initial power supply to Jan 2024. Meanwhile, the meter SI No TWSC590041 was installed on 19.02.2024 with IMR '0' & MF 1 & another meter bearing SL No TWSC59014883 was installed on 14.08.2024 with IMR'0' & MF 1 where it is found that the earlier meter was installed due to meter defective by replacing new smart meter & later was replaced due to burnt of meter. As came to knowledge of the Forum that, the above complainant has paid approximately Rs.30000.00 for the period from April 2015 to April 2024. The complainant during hearing has expressed his displeasure on high billing which was done before installation of meter in that premises & requested to revise the bill as well as reconnect the power supply. It is also seen that in 09.08.2024 Rs.5000.00 has paid by the complainant. As seen the meter installation effected in billing in Aug 2024 with billing units of 39 and hence, assume the power supply was reconnected by the opposite party. During scrutiny of ledger, it is found that the recording of proper billing unit has not seen by this Forum and assumed that there was no load during the past months. Hence, revision is required to settle the billing dispute


Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill by taking six/eight consecutive correct reading of the newly installed meter - with its daily/monthly Actual Average consumption where the point will be in regular use with its load may be includes some non-use periods (cultivated periods with load +non-cultivated periods with no load) which may be six to eight months to derive the actual average consumption for revision purpose & the complaint is supposed to pay the current bill in regular basis.

Final Order(GRF Case No.BRL/500/2024)

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ORDER

Considering the documents and statements submitted by both the parties at the time of hearing, the Forum her passes orders that:



- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period revised earlier and adjust the revision as per law/for the period of penalty/in both cases, if any, as applicable as it has not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the benefits of OTS scheme and rebate thereof, if any, as applicable as it has not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking into account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, serve the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act, 2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived at, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within nine month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
