GIST OF THE CASE

The Complainant has filed the petition in the name of Sri Debi Prasad Garnayak bearing Consumer No 4140-0103-1173 represented by Sri Durga Prasad Garnayak under DED, TPWODL, Deogarh stated about billing dispute.

Hence, the Complainant prayed before the Forum to consider his case for revision/rectification.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSÍTE PARTY

The Opposite Party has submitted the ledger copy for the period from Jul'2017 to Dec'2023 in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is an Irrigation Pumping and Agriculture consumer having CD 2.24kw with date of initial power supply 18.06.2017 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute with prayer to revise the bill. There was no meter at time of initial p/s and billing is continued in average basis from Jul'2017 to Oct'2022 and PL basis till Feb'2023. A new meter was installed bearing meter sl. no."TPU024961" on 10.02.2023. There is average billing from Jul'2017 to Feb'2023 @ 207/144/324/314/395 units/month. After installation of new meter billing is continuing accordingly. So, required revision to settle the billing dispute.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill for the period from Mar'2021 to Feb'2023 by taking consecutive of months consumption with its actual monthly average consumption basing on the meter reading recorded in meter sl. no." TPU024961 as per regulation 155 of OERC(Conditions of Supply) Code,2019.

ORDER

Considering the documents and statements submitted by both the parties at the time of hearing, the Forum hereby passes orders that:

1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill of the consumer for the period from Mar'2021 to Feb'2023 by taking consecutive of months consumption with its actual monthly average consumption basing on the meter reading recorded in meter sl. no." TPU024961" as per regulation 155 of OERC(Conditions of Supply) Code,2019.

- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier and adjust the revision as per law/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
