GIST OF THE CASE

Sri Pradeep Ku Pandey representative of Consumer No 4162-3102-0530 stands in the name of Sri Satyanarayan Pandey bearing is a domestic consumer with CD 0.5KW and date of supply release is 16.01.2019. He has submitted a written complain wherein he stated about billing dispute. Hence, he requests to revise/rectify the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has submitted the PVR carried on 08.01.2024 & no other documents have been submitted in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is persued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-Dom consumer having CD 0.5kw with date of initial power supply 16.01.2019 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute with prayer to revise the bill & also expressed the displeasure. The meter SI No WLT118615 was installed on 20.09.2021 with IMR '0'. Average/Pl bills were served from 16.01.2019 to Sept-2023 (12.10.2023). The opposite party has already been revised the bill for the period from Sept 2021 to Sept 2023 (20.09.2021 to 27.10.2023) for delay meter updating & debited an amount of Rs.152633.31 with KWh reading of 25964 on 27.10.2023 in reference consumption recorded in Meter SI No WLT118615 which has done correctly in accordance to regulation for which the complainant is liable to pay the same. So, required bill revision for settlement of the billing dispute for other periods.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill for the period from 20.09.2019 to 19.09.2021 considering the recorded consumption in meter SI No WLT118615taking the IMR as '0' on 20.09.2021 and FMR as 25964 on 27.10.2023 with its daily/monthly actual average consumption & the complainant is liable to pay the revised bill accordingly. The addition of Rs.152633.31 is correct & hence no need of any bill revision in this case.

ORDER

After careful consideration of hearing and data submitted by both parties the Forum is pleased to pass the Order as follows.

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill for the period from 20.09.2019 to 19.09.2021 considering the recorded consumption in meter SI No WLT118615taking the IMR as '0' on 20.09.2021 and FMR as 25964 on 27.10.2023 with its daily/monthly actual average consumption & the complainant is liable to pay the revised bill accordingly.
- The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
