GIST OF THE CASE

The Complainant filed the petition in the name Sri Antaryami Mallik bearing Consumer No **4172-2506-2050** under BNED, TPWODL, Brajrajnagar stated about billing dispute.

Hence, the Complainant prayed before the Forum to consider the case for revision/rectification.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has submitted ledger copy for the period from May'2019 to Dec'2023 & PVR dtd. 10.01.2024 but not submitted w/s in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is pursued with all documents available in record and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a domestic consumer having CD 1kw with initial date of power supply 30.10.2018 through meter sl. no." WESCO9186863" was installed on 29.10.2018 with IMR "zero" & MF as "1" as seen from the FG data base/Samadhan App. The complainant has been raised objection on billing dispute and pray for its revision. In the meantime, the meter sl. no. "TWSP51096475" was installed on 27.12.2023 IMR as "zero" & MF as "1" where seen with old meter kwh reading as "3100" with reference to meter sl. no. "365295". In PVR dtd. 26.10.2023 of field officers it is mentioned that the meter sl. no. "365295" is in field which was replaced on 27.12.2023 with kwh reading "516" on 10.01.2024 as seen from the photograph of the meter submitted to this Forum might be incorrect but the reading was correct upto 26.12.2023. So, bill revision is required to resolve the grievance of the complainant.

Hence, the Forum is in the opinion that the Opposite party is liable to revise the bills for the period from 30.10.2018 to 26.12.2023 basing on the consumption recorded in meter sl. no. "365295" taking IMR as "zero" kwh by spread the readings "516" over the periods with the daily/monthly actual average consumption thereof but meter to be tested to know about the efficiency and if found any deviation to be treated accordingly as per regulation.

ORDER

Considering the documents and statements submitted by both the parties at the time of hearing, the Forum hereby passes orders that:

1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill of the consumer for the period 30.10.2018 to 26.12.2023 basing on the consumption recorded in meter sl. no."365295" taking IMR as "zero" kwh by spread the readings "516" over the periods with the daily/monthly actual average consumption thereof but meter to be tested to know about the efficiency and if found any deviation to be treated accordingly as per regulation.

- 2. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act,2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
