OPPOSITE PARTY

GIST OF THE CASE

Sri Subal Padhi bearing Consumer No 4118-3101-0016 is a domestic consumer. He has submitted a written complain wherein he stated about billing dispute. Hence, he requests to revise/rectify the bill.

SUBMISSION OF OPPOSITE PARTY

The Opposite Party has submitted the inspection report carried on 03.01.2019 & ledger from April-2018 to Nov-2023 & no other documents have been submitted in this case.

OBSERVATION

The case is persued with all documents available in records submitted by the complainant and merit of the case. On examining the case in details, the Forum observed that the complainant is a LT-Dom consumer having CD 3Kw with date of initial power supply 01.01.1990 as seen from FG/Samadhan App. The complainant has raised objection on billing dispute with prayer to revise the bill & also expressed the displeasure for the period during 2017-18. During course of verification, it is seen that an inspection has been done on 03.01.2019 & finalize the penalty amount for Rs.15768.00 as well as also come to the notice of the Forum that Pl/Avg bills were served during Dec-2015 to Aug-2019 seems to be high @ 432/324 etc monthly/bimonthly as compare the consumption recorded in the Meter Sl No LW296985 was effected in billing in Sept-2019. The ledger is showing that an amount of Rs.40346.00 ha already been debited to the complainant in May-2019 although final assessment has done for Rs.15768.00 & the excess debit amount of Rs.24618.00 at present continued in billing instead of withdrawal the same. So, required bill revision for settlement of the billing dispute for other periods.

Hence it is the opinion of the Forum that the opposite party is liable to revise the bill for the period from June 2016 to May-2018 considering the recorded consumption in meter Sl No LW296985 taking the IMR as '362' in Oct-2019 and FMR as 1051 in April-2020 with its daily/monthly actual average consumption. Further credit sundry for differential excess debit in billing of Rs.24618.00 to be taken care for withdrawal along with DPS & other charges if levied as per applicability.

ORDER

After careful consideration of hearing and data/documents submitted by both parties the forum is to pass the Order as follows.

- 1. The Opposite Party is directed to revise the bill for the period from June 2016 to May-2018 considering the recorded consumption in meter Sl No LW296985 taking the IMR as '362' in Oct-2019 and FMR as 1051 in April-2020 with its daily/monthly actual average consumption. Further credit sundry for differential excess debit in billing of Rs.24618.00 to be taken care for withdrawal along with DPS & other charges if levied as per applicability.
- The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already revised earlier/for the period of penalty/in both cases if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 3. The Opposite party is directed not to consider the bill revision for the period already where the complainant has availed the OTS scheme and rebate thereon if any as applicable as not submitted any information for the same.
- 4. The Opposite Party is directed to serve the revised energy charges bill with revised due date within 30 days from the receipt of this Order, duly considering the applicable tariff during the period, taking in to account the adjustments, if any, and adjustment for the payments made by the complainant and ensure payment thereof.
- 5. The Opposite Party is directed to collect the revised bill amount and on non-payment, served the Disconnection Notice to the Complainant as per Indian Electricity Act, 2003 under Section 56(i) and disconnect the power supply accordingly.
- 6. The Complainant is directed to pay the revised billed amount so arrived, if any, within due date after receipt of the revised energy charges bill to avoid disconnection.
- 7. Opposite party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within one month from the date of issue of this order as the case may be.

Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
